Now that the election season is over, the League of Women Voters of Oregon Education Fund would like to thank you, your donors, and the Multnomah Bar Foundation for officially sponsoring the Oregon Student Mock Election. Your help contributed significantly to the program's success by providing our organization with the resources to share and conduct this important civic education program across the state of Oregon. We could not have done it without the sponsorship from Multnomah Bar Foundation, and we greatly appreciate the opportunities you gave and the support you showed for the Oregon Student Mock Election this year.

As a result of your efforts, over 10,000 students participated in the Oregon Student Mock Election through classroom exercises, voting, or both. This year, students voted to keep all incumbents in office, and voted in favor of all the ballot measures except measure 88. There was a large amount of support for both measures 89, the equal rights amendment, and 92, which mandated the labeling of genetically modified foods. In 2014, we saw a new wave of middle school classrooms and even community college classes participating. We received great feedback from teachers, who relayed how wonderful it was to watch students become active and energized about the voting process for the first time. This important project continues to make a substantial impact in classrooms across the state of Oregon, and across the country.

The League of Women Voters of Oregon Education Fund works to encourage active and informed participation in government and to increase understanding of major policy issues. The Education Fund seeks to empower citizens to understand governmental issues and to participate in the political process. We seek to provide balanced, accurate, nonpartisan information to all Oregonians.
