## Award Screening and Selection Criteria

1. If the nominee is a **LEGAL EMPLOYER**,
  - a. This category includes private or nonprofit law firm, government/public agency, and company with legal department.
  - b. The legal employer must be located in Multnomah County, have at least one office in Multnomah County, or serve the Multnomah County legal community.
  - c. Describe the employer's sustained, long-term efforts in encouraging, increasing and/or maintaining diversity in the legal profession, with particular focus on recruitment, retention and advancement of attorneys from diverse backgrounds.
  - d. Describe and provide specific details and documentation on how the diversity efforts of the legal employer have resulted in increased diversity in the firm and/or legal profession.
  - e. Describe the legal employer's size, practice areas, etc. and/or pro bono activities.
2. If the nominee is an **INDIVIDUAL ATTORNEY**,
  - a. Overall, please describe how the nominated individual meets the goals set forth in the Statement of Diversity.
  - b. Describe the nominee's efforts to encourage, increase and/or maintain diversity in the legal profession and/or demonstrates a commitment to addressing equality, diversity, civil rights, civil liberties, or human rights in the legal profession.
  - c. Explain whether the efforts above were made within the scope of employment or on a voluntary basis and what has been the impact of the nominated individual's efforts.
  - d. Describe the nominee's practice setting, including the size of the firm, the firm's practice areas, and the nominee's principal areas of practice.
  - e. Attach a current résumé or biography with work history and educational background (if possible).
  - f. Any MBA practicing attorney member, except a member of the MBA Equality and Diversity Committee or the MBA Board of Directors, is eligible to receive this award. Former nominees may be re-nominated.
3. If the nominee is any **OTHER LEGAL ORGANIZATION (NONPROFIT/ BAR ASSOCIATION/ LAW SCHOOL)**,
  - a. Other legal organization includes a nonprofit organization, bar association, or law school that is either located in Multnomah County or serving the Multnomah County legal community.
  - b. Describe the nominee's efforts to address issues of access and bias in the legal profession, influences individuals historically under-represented in the legal profession to pursue legal careers, increases advancement opportunities for lawyers who have been historically under-represented.
  - c. Describe the impact of those efforts and how those efforts serve the Multnomah County legal community.
