Justice for All: Understanding and Applying Oregon's New Prohibition on Courthouse Immigration Arrests

In November 2019, Chief Justice Martha Walters issued a Chief Justice Order making immediately effective UTCR 3.190, which prohibits civil immigration arrests without a judicial warrant in and around Oregon's state courthouses. The new UTCR was issued in response to the increased number of arrests made by plainclothes Immigration & Customs Enforcement (ICE) agents with administrative warrants only, and the impacts of those arrests on the ability of state courts to operate and administer justice. Join speakers **Nadia Dahab**, Innovation Law Lab and **Leland Baxter-Neal**, ACLU of Oregon, for this CLE program, which will involve a discussion of the scope of the UTCR, its basis in Oregon law, and potential mechanisms for enforcement.
