## Joint Defense, Common Interest, and Settlement Privileges

Navigating Confidentiality Obligations to Third-Parties

The joint defense, common interest, and settlement negotiation privileges require extending our duty to maintain the confidentiality of communications to third parties, who sometimes can or will have adverse interests to our clients. In doing so, these privileges raise intriguing and complicated legal and ethical issues. Who can waive the privileges and under what circumstances? When should the scope and nature of these privileges be put into written agreements and when, if ever, should they not? Will the government penalize companies who enter into joint defense agreements with individuals alleged to have engaged in wrongdoing? To what extent does our commitment to maintain confidential communications with a third party raise ethical obligations and potential conflicts.
