Privilege and Ethics Issues Related to In-House General Counsel within a Small or Mid-sized Law Firm

To what extent can lawyers within the same small or mid-sized law firm communicate confidentially regarding an ethics or malpractice issue involving a current client? The Oregon Supreme Court decision in *Crimson Trace v. Davis Wright Tremaine LLP*, 355 Or 476, __ P3d __ (2014) resolved privilege issues in the context of a large firm but did not consider whether a smaller firm may have in-house counsel and the relevant privilege, client relations, and ethics questions that may arise. Join **Dan Keppler** of Kennedy Watts Arellano LLP, **Mark Fucile** of Fucile & Reising LLP, and **Bruce Schafer** of the Professional Liability Fund, who will discuss the privilege implications of the *Crimson Trace* decision, unresolved ethics concerns, and risk management issues related to small and mid-sized firms having in-house counsel.
