 - 7:00 - 7:30 pm, in *Partnership with City Club of Portland*, **Multnomah County Auditor**, Scott Learn and Jennifer McGuirk
 - 7:40 - 8:20 pm, **Metro Ballot Measure 26-199**, Metro affordable housing bonds, and **Oregon Ballot Measure 102**, Allows local bonds for financing affordable housing with nongovernmental entities
 - 8:30 - 9:00pm, **Oregon Ballot Measure 105**, Repeals law limiting state/local enforcement of federal immigration laws.
